## What the children will be learning...

The children will be sharing lots of stories about growing and planting. We will continue our learning about seasonal change and see how our local environment has changed moving into Spring time. We will be beginning to identify odd and even numbers and number bonds to 5 and 10. This is definitely something that we can practise at home! We have become super starts at identifying some 2D shapes so Mrs Fleming is going to challenge us to some 3D shapes this next half term. In phonics we will begin to reading some words with 4 sounds and consolidating reading whole sentences independently.

## How can you help your child?

Please give your child as many opportunities as you can to write. Whether that be a shopping list, a letter or a birthday card, we would love to see evidence of this. It would be great if you could spend some time with your child practising their number bonds to 5. How about getting 5 objects and sorting them into 2 groups, perhaps by colour and talking about there is still 5 altogether. Please ask Miss Hymers for any support you can be doing at home. When reading stories at home, please ask your children questions. How is the character feeling? What do you think might happen next? This will enhance those comprehension skills moving into Key Stage 1. Please can we ask that you access activities which are being set each weekend on Seesaw. If for whatever reason you are unable to get onto Seesaw, please speak to Miss Hymers.
