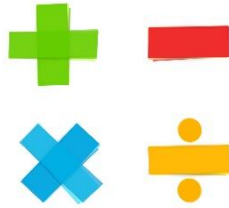


Summer 1 – Year 6

Maths

We will be studying angle names and how to recognise them. Our studies will include finding adjacent angle sizes using protractors and known rules.



We are then moving on to geometry, studying the properties of shape. We will study nets and the structure of 3D shape.

We'll finish the half term by completing our SATS mathematic papers, three in total.

English – Writing

In writing we are reading the Firework Maker's daughter and emulating the style of writing to produce narrative, metaphor and pathetic fallacy.

We will work on speech within dialogue, mixing direct and reported speech.

English – Reading

We have been enjoying a wide variety of texts this year. This term we will complete Skellig, while moving onto Crater Lake with a mysterious content.

Curriculum

We are learning all about local area in History. Ask children to observe what they see around them. If they are in town, try to get them to discuss the types of buildings they see. In science we are studying electricity. We will be looking at how different forms of electricity are found around us, how volts can change the power of a charge and how components function.
