
## Nursery Newsletter






We are starting this half term thinking about our families, who lives in our house and who we love by sharing the story 'Owl Babies' – we have to find the owls first by using the map we constructed in Autumn 1!

We will share the story The Colour Monster to explore our feelings. The Colour Monster is a lovely book to buy as a Christmas present. We will also be thinking about what is special about us and who is special to them and using toys in our Chatterbox to help us.

Later in the half term we will learn about the Christmas story, learn some Christmas songs and do a little bit of acting so we can perform the Nativity for you all. The date for our Nativity is Monday 16t<sup>h</sup> December (am).



How can you help your child?

Keep counting as much as possible – look at the arrangement of objects. Can you 'see' one thing, two things, three things. Encourage the children to count out 3 objects or 4 objects for example 3 pieces of fruit, 4 sweets.

Share stories as much as possible and talk about what is happening. Ask your child if they like the story (and why). Use words such as why, what, how in your questions....



In the cloakroom there is a parent information board with lots of information about reading, safeguarding and other info.

I will start to add activities on Seesaw in the near future. We will share the codes at the beginning of the half term. We will also be starting morning activities from week 2. We hope you can join us. It is so helpful to the children in their learning.
