Maths

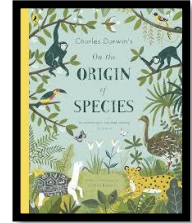

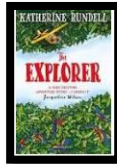
English – Writing

Curriculum
